Her arrival will coincide with the Horn Shelter Renovation installation, which also will take place in October. 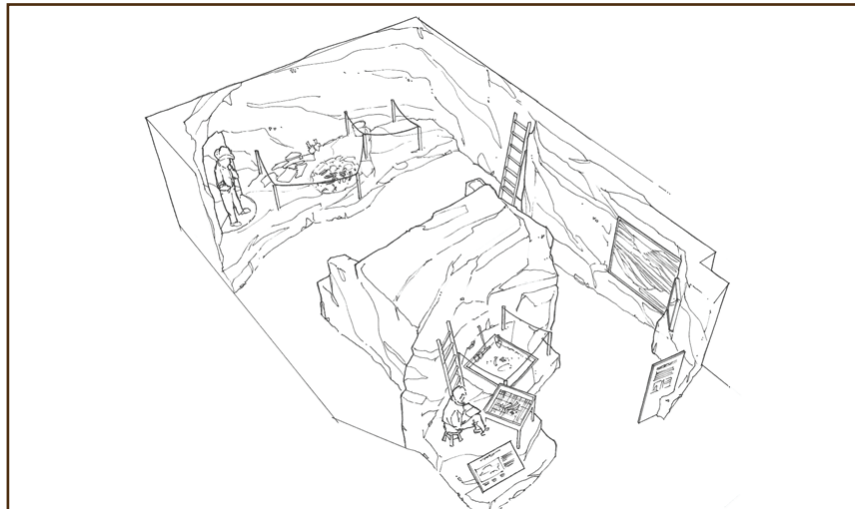
